## Pool Closure: May 2023-August 2023

As a reflection of Hunter's spirit, his family designated the YMCA as a beneficiary of the contributions made in his honor. These donations are serving to enhance and develop our YMCA aquatics space.

Since 1965 our pool has served as Knox County's only public indoor pool providing year-round family recreation, physical fitness, lifeguard instructor training, swim clubs, and swim lessons. In 2022, renovations to the YMCA pool were concentrated on infrastructure to ensure the pool would continue to serve for many more generations and decades. The closure in 2023 will concentrate on overall employee and patron experience. Some of the renovations will be:

- Removal of ceiling
- New LED lighting
- Acoustic sound panels
- Repair of current ceramic tile
